



## Colorado Athletics Directors Association Scholarship Guidelines

Colorado Athletics Directors Association (CADA) would like to establish a scholarship program for Colorado High School Students Athletes. CADA believes in developing positive programs that reward:

- The student who goes beyond the usual through hard work and discipline required by participation in high school athletics.
- Financial support for the scholarship program to come from the CADA treasury.
- Time sequence of the program:
  - Application to be mailed via Fall and Winter Issues of the CADA Newsletter.
  - Deadline for applications will be February 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - Notification of selection will be by the end of February.
  - Presentation of the awards at the Annual Conference.
  - Publication of winners will be in the summer edition of the CADA newsletter.

During each school year CADA will award one \$500 scholarship honoring the top high school male and female student-athlete.

Only students graduating during the current school year will be eligible for the scholarships. All nominees will be recognized with award certificates.

### Awards will be presented on the following criteria:

1. A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
2. Involvement in school sponsored activities
3. Involvement in activities outside of school (work, charities)
4. Two letters of support
5. A **500 word essay** describing how co-curricular activities have enhanced the student's educational experience. **Essay must be typed.**
6. A wallet size photograph suitable for reproduction must also be submitted with the application.

Regional and local honorees will be presented certificates and the scholarship winners will be honored at the annual Spring Conference in April. All scholarship money will be paid directly to the students for their first year of course work.

CADA is: A state professional organization administered by and for athletic directors for the purpose of promoting professional growth and image of interscholastic athletic administrators.

Please complete and mail the following application from with your completed essay and two letters of recommendation attached. Incomplete entries will **not** be considered.
