NIAAA PRODUCT/VIDEO DESCRIPTIONS

Guide for College-Bound Student-Athletes and Their Parents is a tool to better serve student-athletes and their parents with the process of preparing for the selection of a college or university. The guide focuses on key elements as they occur from the beginning and through the final decision. In addition, it also includes the NCAA Eligibility Clearinghouse procedures. The revised 2007 guides are available for purchase and will include the most up-to-date changes made by the NCAA.

Athletic Administration: A Comprehensive Guide – This DVD format provides practical materials, successful methods, innovative strategies, checklists and numerous examples of forms, letters and evaluation tools. The manual features information addressing Athletics and the Law, Risk Management, Personnel, Finance, Turf Management, Public Relations, Student-athlete Guidelines, Sportsmanship, Fund-raising and Promotions, and much more. DVD format allows you to download forms that might be applicable to your program without having to keystroke the entire form.

Risk Management DVD – This DVD is a 2007 Risk Management production DVD with two chapters. The first is a six-minute video directed at parents and student-athletes, and warns of the inherent risks associated with participating in interscholastic athletics and activities; the second is a 15-minute presentation aimed at the coach and administrator which outlines the 14 legal duties coaches and administrators are bound by when working with young people. This new DVD replaces the risk management videos produced in the 1990s.

Hazing Education DVD – At one time confined almost exclusively to colleges, today hazing has become a much more significant issue at the high school level with more than 1.5 million incidents reported each year.

One unit on the DVD will inform students and parents:

- What is hazing?
- What are the results and consequences of hazing?
- What can be done to prevent it from happening?

Another unit on the DVD will inform athletic and activity administrators, principals and coaches:

- What is hazing?
- Why does hazing take place?
- Hazing and the law.
- Why anti-hazing school policies and procedures are important.

A third unit on the DVD will catalog every state's anti-hazing adopted laws.

Pitcher's Mound/Batter's Box Construction DVD – This DVD provides step-by-step instructions as to the correct process to construct a baseball/softball pitcher's mound, as well as batter's boxes.

Softball/Baseball Skin Infield Care and Maintenance – This DVD outlines the proper procedures to care for and maintain an skin infield for either baseball or softball.

Line to Gain DVD – Line to Gain crews are extensions of the officiating crew. Now they can receive the training they need to perform their duties more professionally. The video explains and demonstrates proper techniques and procedures, which apply to all levels of football.
